Trolley rolls through Western Shore beach communities

CHESAPEAKE BEACH, Md. - If you're looking for an inexpensive option to go to the Chesapeake Bay but don't want to cross the Bay Bridge, you may want to hop on Route 4 and head to Chesapeake Beach and North Beach.

A new trolley is rolling through Chesapeake Beach, North Beach and into Deale -- and it's quite a bargain.

It's a quarter.

The [trolley](#) runs round trip every two hours, giving you the chance to check out the beach at North Beach, the Chesapeake Beach Railway Museum and the Chesapeake Beach Water Park.

Also on the trolley route are several popular bars and restaurants, including Rod 'N' Reel in Chesapeake Beach and Skipper's Pier in Deale.

The trolley runs Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays through Labor Day. It operates from 3 p.m. Friday to 1 a.m. Saturdays, from 9 a.m. Saturday to 1 a.m. Sunday and from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. Sundays and holiday Mondays.
